January 22, 2026

The Board of Commissioners of the Acadia St. Landry Hospital Service District met on Thursday, January 22, 2026 at 5:15 pm in the Acadia St. Landry Hospital Board Room at 810 South Broadway Street, Church Point, Louisiana.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

- The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lee Ward Bellard on January 22, 2026 at 5:20 pm.

**PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:**

#### **2024-2025 ASLH FINANCIAL AUDIT REPORT**

- Bryan Joubert, CPA Auditor with Kolder, Slaven & Company, presented the 2024-2025 ASLH Financial Audit Report. Joubert reported that ASLH had a clean report with no findings.
- Motion by T. Cook, second by R. Broussard to approve the 2024-2025 ASLH Financial Audit Report. A vote was called, motion passed unanimously.

#### **CEO REPORT:**

In the way of the CEO report, LeJeune stated the following:

- On January 13<sup>th</sup> & 14 we had a revenue cycle management specialist consultant onsite. She did an initial evaluation of our processes and will be sending us a report in the coming days. Based on her exit report, we will likely be engaging with her to sure up our entire RCM processes.
- On January 15<sup>th</sup> we received our audit from the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy. Very pleased to report that had no zero conditional findings! Congratulations to Sammye and Stephanie on their efforts to complete a successful audit.
- Our attorney Taylor Guidry and our Nurse Practitioner at Fleur De Lis Morgan Thomas have both had their babies. Both mom and baby are doing wonderful.
- Door access points were installed yesterday at the second set of double glass doors next to the PT entrance. This was the last external door to secure. Also, we added an access point to medical records. This will assist with audits as it relates to who has access or has been in the department.
- Acadiana Smiles Dental group has officially taken over Dr. Briggs practice. Dr. Gonzalez and his staff have hit the ground running.
- Last week, through the efforts of HR Director, Dawn Woods, ASLH enrolled in the “Shoes for Crews” program. This program is provided at no cost to the hospital. It allows employees to purchase specialty shoes (such as non-slip) and the ability to payroll deduct them so they can pay overtime versus a one lump sum payment.
- It used to take us months to get resumes for any position. Last week we posted 2 positions and we had to take them down in less than 24 hours. Between the 2 positions, we received near 50 applications. We are in the process of review applications and interviewing. We have informed all applicants that this process may take us a little time.
